Tuesday 11 October 2022

Depart Dublin for your onward flight to Tel Aviv – flight times to be confirmed. Transfer to Galilee for overnight. Transfer to the 3* Restal hotel in Tiberias for overnight.

Wednesday 12 October 2022

Breakfast at hotel. Full day tour around the lake of Galilee. There is nowhere more beautiful in Galilee region than the sea of Galilee itself. Step back in time to around 2000 years ago and visit the places most of us have heard of. From Capernaum to Mount of Beatitudes. This leisurely day will give you some free time for lunch and will finish with a trip to Magdala – this ancient city has just been discovered in the last few years and every step unfolds a new archaeological discovery. Return to hotel for dinner and overnight.



Thursday 13 October 2022



Check out after breakfast. This morning you will head west towards the Mediterranean Sea and ultimately your cruise. As you travel west you will bypass Cana and visit Nazareth Village. Here you will have the opportunity to visit a fantastic village re-enacting life in Biblical times – there are some interesting facts to be learned there. As you depart Nazareth, the Carmel Mountains are in view. The coach will take you to the top of the mountains where you will have time to view the valley of Armageddon (Jezreel Valley) and look back towards Jerusalem.

Arrive at the cruise port around 1pm for embarkation.

Wednesday 19 October 2022

Collection From cruise terminal after breakfast at 9.30am.

Pick up from Cruise Terminal Haifa around 9am and enjoy a scenic drive from Haifa to Jerusalem, passing through the Jezreel Valley. Lunch stop (at own expense). An opportunity to stop at the River Jordan on route. The 3* Shalom Hotel will be your hotel stop for the next 5 nights. Dinner and overnight.



Thursday 20 October 2022

After breakfast you will travel to your starting point of your walking tour of the Old City by coach. The Old City is an amazing place and a mix of 4 quarters. Today you will have the opportunity to visit the Western Wall and take the journey through the Biblical passage of the steps of the cross. You will pass the Pool of Bethesda, Ecco Homo Arch and see just what it was like in ancient times in an old city that is still very much alive and bursting with diversity.



Return to hotel for dinner and overnight

Friday 21 October 2022

Your morning starts with a trip by coach to the Mount of Olives. The viewpoint is amazing. Be careful though, there may be a few guys selling camel rides around here and looking for photo opportunities. All part of the culture there. Here you can look across the valley to Jerusalem, see the Dome of the Rock and get a good geographical picture of what the city was like during the various eras it has past through. As you wander downwards from the lowest part of the mountain you will pass the tomb of Prince



Philip's mother and arrive at the Garden of Gethsemane – 1000 year old olive trees still bloom there. From a Biblical perspective, this area is the most important to Christians who consider where Jesus spent His last few days before His crucifixion. From here you visit St Peter in Gallicantu – better known as the House of Caiaphas – it is here that Jesus is thought to have spent His last night before His crucifixion when He was betrayed and taken here by the Roman soldiers. It is also thought to be the scene of Peter's denial. The only remaining original steps into the city commence here.

After lunch and some free time in the old city to wander you will head towards the Garden Tomb. This is an area most commonly known as Calvary and the area where Jesus would have been buried in the tomb of Joseph. A perfect ending to a perfect day. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Saturday 22 October 2022

Free day – it is Jewish Shabbat which means there are no Jewish sites open today but it is a perfect day to go for a wander or a coffee in the Christian quarter.



You have the option today to take a day trip to the Dead Sea. Around 1 hour south of Jerusalem you can enjoy a dip in the salty waters of the Dead Sea – even if you can't swim, you can certainly float here. Its therapeutic properties are excellent. On the way you will get a chance to visit Qumran where the shepherd boy found one of the most amazing archaeological finds of the last 2000 years, by accident. A cable car will also take you to Masada, the last remaining fortress of the Jews and a former palace of Herod – it is a must on this trip! (Cost per person £99)

Sunday 23 October 2022



Free day to go shopping or explore other parts of the city. This evening you will have early dinner before leaving the hotel to go to the walls of David's Citadel in the Jewish quarter. Tonight, you will experience a light show on the walls of the Old city that bring you right back in time to the first stone laid in this magnificent city. The show will last approximately one hour.

Return to hotel for overnight.

Monday 24 October 2022

Breakfast and depart hotel for airport and onward journey to Dublin.
